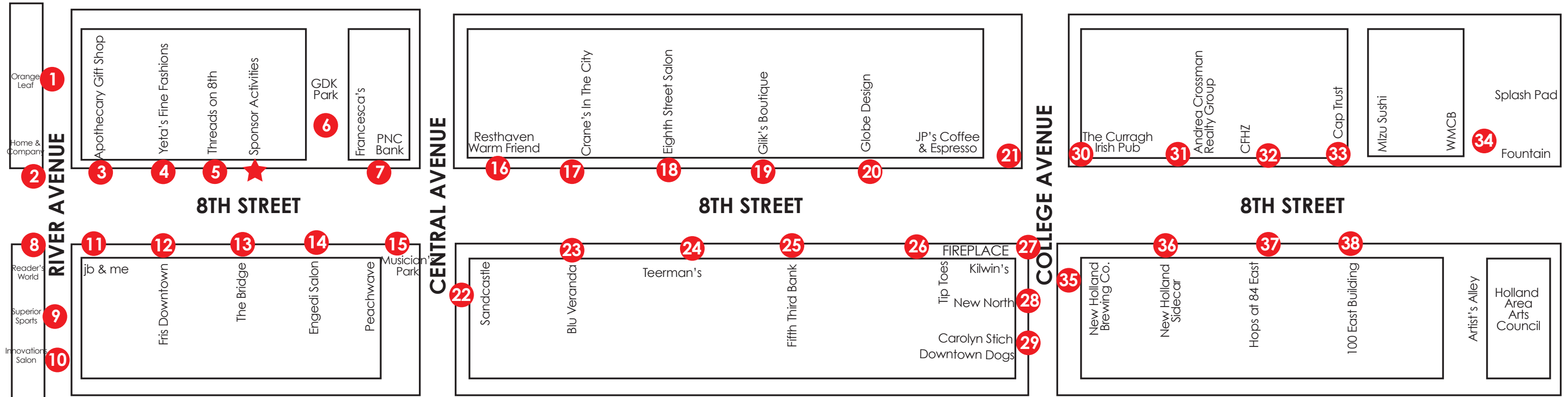

Brother Adams
Brother Adams is a 3-piece band from Holland, formed in the spring of 2013. The band consists of brothers Jairimi and Bryce Driesenga, who are joined by Shane Adams. The trio produces a harmony-laden, boot-stompin', edge-of-your-seat live show and sound that friends and fans have been known to affectionately describe as "'saloon rock".
