It's Time to Plant the Tulips!

HOLLAND, Mich., September 10, 2015 –Tulip Time, together with the City of Holland Parks Department, will host a Community Tulip Planting Day on October 10, 2015 at Window on the Waterfront Park, located on 6th Street between Columbia and College Avenues, from 8:00a - 12:00p. Rain date will be October 17, 2015, same time and place. Volunteers are needed for 2 shifts 8:00a -10:00a and 10:00a -12:00p shifts.

Each fall the City of Holland plants over 300,000 tulip bulbs throughout downtown Holland, city parks, and Tulip Lanes. The Community Planting Day Volunteers will help plant 50,000 tulip bulbs at Window on the Waterfront Park. The Tulip Time Festival Board and Staff have assisted the Parks Department in planting bulbs for several years. "This is a great way to get involved with the Festival," commented Gwen Auwerda, Executive Director of Tulip Time. "And, in the spring, you'll have bragging rights and can show off the tulips you planted to your friends and family!"

Dress for the weather, bring your green thumbs and gardening gloves. The City of Holland Parks Department will supply the bulbs and necessary tools for planting.
